



Chess Lessons: For Serious Students Only!

Interested in seriously improving your chess?
Come and learn with **USCF National Master William Aramil**

- My current USCF is 2240 and I have a Fide of 2222
- I have been teaching chess for 6 years
- In 2002 and 2003 I was the Illinois Denker Qualifier High School Champion (Winner represents the state of Illinois in the Denker Tournament of High School State Champions)
- In 2003 I was the winner of the Denker Tournament of High School State Champions
- In the 2004 I won the Collegiate section of the K-12/ Collegiate Championships
- In addition, I have won multiple class prizes up to U2450
- Also, I have won 2 Grandmasters, and drawn 7 Grandmasters
- Most notably I drew GM Alexander Onischuk the 2006 U.S Champion and the current number 41 player in the world according to FIDE

Rates

- I offer one trial session for \$80 for 2 hours
- Afterwards: the program is 5 sessions consisting of 2 hours per session
- (A total of 10 hours of Chess Lessons)
- The entire program is \$400 (Full Payment in Advance is Required))
- All 5 sessions must take place within a two month time span
- Both parties will sign a brief contract

Details of Chess Lesson Program

- It includes game analysis prior to the actual lesson, work on tactics, endgames, opening concepts, strategical ideas, and there will be homework after every lesson
- Before every lesson I would like 2 notated games sent via e-mail preferably in PGN format, typed, or the score sheets scanned (Therefore I can pin point particular weaknesses, and improve upon these areas)
- I will also give a handout or packet prior to every lesson discussing material of that session
- I stress tactics and endgames to develop analytical and calculatory skills
- The victor in a chess game is not decided by memorization, rather decided by ones ability to see further in advance with an accurate evaluation
- Instead of focusing on memorizing openings, I will discuss ideas and strategies for understanding the opening
- In addition I will give homework or puzzles after every session in the areas of focus such as tactics and endgames
- Additional materials recommended: GM RAM by Rashid Ziatdinov, 101 Tips to Improve Your Chess by Tony Kosten, Endgame Manual by Mark Dvoretsky, and 1001 Winning Chess Sacrifices and Combinations by Fred Reinfeld
